

**Regular Council Meeting
Tuesday, September 7, 2010

The Mayor and Council of the City of Maysville met on Tuesday, September 7, 2010, 7:00 p.m. at the Maysville Library.

PRESENT: Mayor Jerry Baker, Councilmember's Clay Dorsey, Lynn Villyard, Stephan Lewis, City Clerk Barbara Thomas. City Attorney Jody Cooley was not present.

APPROVE MINUTES:

The minutes of the Regular Meeting of August 2, 2010, Public Hearing August 12, 2010, Special Called Meeting August 12, 2010, Special Called Meeting August 19, 2010 was approved as presented upon a motion made by Councilmember Clay Dorsey, seconded by Lynn Villyard. Motion carried.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE:

Mayor Baker opened the meeting with the invocation and pledge of allegiance to the flag. The invocation was given by Councilmember Clay Dorsey.

OLD BUSINESS:

The bids for paving Del Ray were discussed by Council. This was tabled due to gathering more information on what needs to be done to the road. Several citizens that live on Del Ray were present to express their concerns about some safety issues on the road.

NEW BUSINESS:

The city council voted to replace three computers at the library-\$634.00 each, total of \$1,902.00. A motion was made by Councilmember Clay Dorsey, seconded by Lynn Villyard to approve the purchase of three computers to be paid out of Jackson County Library SPLOST funds. Motion carried.

JHC Corporation requested that a change order be approved for the cost of removing a tank in front of the Fat Finch and filling the hole with concrete. This was approved upon a motion made by Councilmember Clay Dorsey, seconded by Lynn Villyard. Motion carried.

A drive up secure drop box was approved as presented to the council. The motion was made by Councilmember Stephan Lewis, seconded by Clay Dorsey. Motion carried. This will be paid out of Jackson County SPLOST.
