The icy weather on January 30 caused us to postpone our author event with best-selling author Lauretta Hannon at the Maysville Public Library, but we have rescheduled her visit for February 20, 2010 at 11 AM. Lauretta is the author of *The Cracker Queen—A Memoir of a Jagged, Joyful Life*, an equally poignant, uproarious, gutsy story that critics have called ‘the perfect antidote for our present hard times.’

Dubbed the anti-Southern belle, Lauretta brings a voice to the fearlessly flawed, yet resourceful, funny and sometimes shocking

women of the South. A commentator on National Public Radio’s *All Things Considered*, Lauretta spins her yarns and shares vignettes that chronicle her sometimes hilarious, sad and off-the-wall life stretching from south Georgia to Europe, to Savannah and Powder Springs and all points in between.
