**The Council appointed Christina Cotton to the Library Board, term ending June 2013... This was approved by Councilmember Lynn Villyard, seconded by Clay Dorsey. Motion carried.**

**The city received a grant in aid check from Jackson County, \$5,636.00. Approval was made to spend \$1500.00 on new books for the Maysville Library. The rest will be used for the up keep and repairs on the building. This was approved by Councilmember Stephan Lewis, seconded by Lynn Villyard. Motion carried.**

**An Intergovernmental Agreement was approved between Maysville and Jackson County for assistance in patching of City Street. The cost to the city would be materials only. This agreement was approved by Councilmember Stephan Lewis, seconded by Lynn Villyard. Motion carried.**

**A proclamation was approved to proclaim February through May as Relay Season in the City of Maysville. This was approved by a motion made by Councilmember Clay Dorsey, seconded by Stephan Lewis. Motion carried.**
